Happy New Year and a Prosperous 2017.

We would like to take this opportunity to ask your Board to rejoin the Canadian Hellenic Congress (CHC).

As you are aware, the Congress held its 34<sup>th</sup> Annual Convention and Conference in Toronto during the last weekend of November 2016. Present at the meeting were delegates from British Columbia, Manitoba, Ontario and Quebec. The work of the National Council was reviewed and policy directions were given to the National Council. Among the acts taken, a new National Council was elected. A list of the Officers and Directors is attached.
